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Embroidery Products

EMBROIDERY PRODUCTS

- ✘ The purpose of this video is to define what an embroidery product is and how to maintain the data.
- ✘ When a user chooses to add embroidery to a garment they have to select the color, font style and number of lines they want to enter.
- ✘ This combination of attributes equals one product in JDE. This also equals one product in the website.

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- ✘ **Garments** – actual wearable being bought - Hanes Stedman Ladies' 7 oz. Cotton Pique Polo - BLACK – S. This is a product in the website.
- ✘ **Garment Types** – general classification of the different type of garments that embroidery can be placed on - shirt, jacket, hat, etc.
- ✘ **Placements** – the location a design or embroidery can be applied - Shirt-Left Collar Tip. Placements are mapped to garment types.
- ✘ **Embroidery Products** – also a product in the website. Each one holds an attribute value for color, font style and number of lines.

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- ✘ Below are the fields required to create an embroidery product in the website:
 - + Status: set to “1” to display, “0” to not display.
 - + Sku: a unique value from all other products. Typically jde number
 - + Nm: this will display when user selects the embroidery product on product page and in shopping cart.
 - + Type: set to “std emb”
 - + Opt6: JDE number
 - + Searchfield6: placement id
 - + Searchfield7: color
 - + Searchfield8: font type – script or block
 - + Searchfield9: number of lines, 1-3
 - + Searchfield10: character limit for line(s)
 - + Thumb: image that appears when embroidery product selected
